**“Big Enough to Worship”
1 Kings 18**

1. Share a story in your life where you really sensed that it was a “Mount Carmel” like experience for you. Where God was impressing upon you the need to choose between him and something else.
2. Why do you think we continue to struggle with “limping between these two opinions”? Of struggling between God and ourselves as God in our lives? Do you have any examples from this week that show you that this is an ongoing struggle?
3. Note Romans 7:7ff (take a look at it in a contemporary translation)
4. How would you answer from Scripture the question, “is Jesus God?”
5. Look at John 1:1-14; Colossians 1:15-20; John 8:45-59; others
6. Share an example of how you believe you may have attempted to manipulate God to act on your behalf
7. Do you ever find yourself approaching God simply because you want blessing? Do you think that in and of itself is a problem? Why?
8. Spend some time worshiping God. Recount all that he has done for you through Jesus. Cry out to him and announce your thanksgiving and praise of him not for what you can receive but for what you can give to him.
9. In the story of Elijah repentance preceded rain. It may be that you need to confess and repent (change your mind and actions) that you are at a point in your life where you have chosen Baal instead of YHWH (Jesus). Do it now!
