1. What did you walk away with from Sunday's message? What were your overall impressions? How did God speak into your life?
2. How do you balance the biblical ideas of (a) pursuing holiness and purity and (b) reaching out to those who do not know Jesus and do not have the same values that you do?
Leader Hints:
Remember the problem that the Pharisees had—they were much more interested in maintaining the aura of purity than in helping those who needed to know God. Our pursuit of holiness must not get in the way of our passion for people.
3. Other than the coffee shop, what are some of your favourite “third spaces”? Why?
Leader Hints:
A “third space” is a place where people naturally gather socially, let their guard down, are more at ease with one another. It is an informal place where conversation takes place.
4. Do you have any “third space” stories where people just opened up in conversation with you? What happened?
5. Share an example of a time when someone did something ordinary or simple that made a profound difference in your life.
6. When did you last talk with an unchurched person about Jesus? Why do you suppose that some believers have a hard time telling others about Christ?
7. Evaluate your own small group. Are you more like a religious social club, a support group, or a group on mission? What do you think that your small group should be more like?
