



## Launch Your Senses!

Taking it home



As a church we believe, and research has shown that kids are influenced by their parents more than any other people in life. That being said, we have given you a small list of ideas that may help you to reinforce the Biblical principles introduced in this month's BLAST program. These ideas are designed to compliment your individual learning style and are based upon one or more of the five senses:

### Prayer Photo Album



Visual



Touch



Auditory

**The Idea:** Create a picture album as a visual reminder of who you are praying for as a family. Your small children can use this as a reference for whom to pray.

**What you need:** Pictures of family, friends & leaders. Construction paper. Glue. If you use the alternative idea, you will need crayons or markers.

**Begin:** Gather together pictures of family members, friends and church leaders (especially your child's BLAST teacher(s)) and create an album using the picture. As an alternative, you could have your younger children draw pictures of these people. You can then organize the pictures onto construction paper to create large index cards.

**Pray:** Each time you gather as a family to pray, use the pictures to guide your prayers.

### Musical Prayer Chairs



Visual



Touch



Auditory

Set up one chair for each child present.

Tape a prayer need/idea to the back of each seat.

Line up your children in a circle and explain that when the music plays, they walk around the chairs like normal and when the music stops, everyone gets a chair.

To pick who prays, randomly pick the numbers that represent the prayer needs/requests. After the prayer, have everyone stand up again and start the music.

Work your way through each of the requests until they are all covered.
