Here's a little write up in regards to our ministries during the past 6 months. I have put a power point presentation in the mail. It gives an overview of our ministry during the past 6 months. The Lord has blessed and brought forth much fruit for our labours and for the labours of those who partner with us.

Here in New Brunswick Judy's counseling ministry continues to flourish as she has about 14 people she meets with weekly. Many have a new walk with the Lord and He is helping them to overcome their hurts, habits and hangups. Some have moved on, understand their salvation in Christ, have been baptised, joined the church and are now serving the Lord by helping others enter the same assurance of God's love for them. Still many more come seeking help.

In Bolivia we rejoice as to what God is doing. On our last trip there in May we handed out the 20,000th radio since we began this ministry in March of 2005. Many have come to Christ, some new churches have been started, several have a better understanding of who they are in Christ. Some of the young men who have served with us are now studying and persuing fulltime service in the ministry to reach their own people, the Quechua. A nation is being affected by the Gospel through the little radios. It's estimated that these 20,000 radios now enable approximately three quarters of a million Quechua to hear the Word of God , most for the first time in a way they could understand it.

We have plans to take 3 more teams this year with another 4400 radios. Praise God the teams are all filled and the radios are being provided. Surely the Lord intends to build His church as He said He would.

Thanks to OBC for being such a significant part in our lives and ministries both here at home as well as in Bolivia. Blessings to all.
